Light, Life and Love: A Series in 1 John Do Not Be Deceived 1 John 4:1-6

"Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God..."

1 John 4:1

Main Point: Loving Christians are not deceived.

"For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not confess the coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh. Such a one is the deceiver and the antichrist."

2 John 7

Point One: Christian faith is not spiritual gullibility.

How can I be deceived?

- 1. By failing to show love (3:18)
- 2. By not properly testing the spirits (4:1)
- 3. By not knowing sound doctrine (4:2-3)
- 4. By not listening to the Spirit and others (4:6)

Unfortunately, those who deceive are successful because they present themselves as being true.

Point Two: Christian faith is greater than spiritual deception.

"Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father."

John 14:12

Point Three: Christian faith does not accommodate the world's beliefs.

A test: The Holy Spirit's presence vs. the antichrist:

- 1. Confession of Jesus Christ who came in the flesh (4:1-3)
- 2. Hearing and obeying the Gospel (3:4-10; 4:6)
- 3. True believers are *not* following (4:5)

"I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father."
