“For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality...For God has not called us for impurity, but in holiness.”

1 Thess. 4:3, 7

Point Three: Revival is a Spirit-led _____.

“And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and young men shall see visions.”

Joel 2:28

Is there true evidence of the Spirit of God in your life?

Point Four: Revival happens when Christians are _____ with the Holy Spirit.

“But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.”

Galatians 5:16

Walking in the Spirit means...

- Dealing with all sin that is hindering the Spirit (5:17)
- Confessing specific sin and repenting (5:19-21)
- Displaying spiritual, beneficial fruit for all to see (5:22-23)
